TESTING, INSPECTION AND CERTIFICATION COUNCIL:

We recognise the importance of our industry body, TIC, and have actively engaged with them to improve

compliance across our Group and participate in annual audits of our processes and documentation.

particular anti-bribery and corruption; and

Periodic review of third party's payment requests and payments.

EFFECTIVENESS IN COMBATING SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING:

Through using our network of trusted suppliers and with improved vetting of new suppliers (including

financial and adverse media checks) we are pleased to say that we have not identified any instance of

modern slavery during the year across our supply chain.

We are committed to continuously improving our efforts to prevent and address modern slavery in our

operations and supply chains. We will continue to review and update our policies and procedures to ensure

that they are effective in preventing modern slavery. AHK is committed to growing our compliance and
