**OUR POLICIES**

**Supplier Due Diligence**: We conduct thorough due diligence on our suppliers to assess and mitigate the risk of modern slavery and human trafficking. This includes evaluating their policies, practices, and commitment to human rights and whether they hold policies that meet the standard of Alfred H Knight's Compliance and Corporate Governance requirements.

**Employee Awareness and Training**: We provide ongoing training and awareness programs to our employees to ensure they understand the risks of modern slavery and their responsibilities in preventing it. We encourage employees to report any concerns or suspicions.

**Whistleblowing Policy**: We have a confidential reporting mechanism, including a whistleblowing policy, to allow employees, clients, suppliers, or anyone working with us to report any suspected cases of modern slavery or human trafficking without fear of retaliation.

TESTING, INSPECTION AND CERTIFICATION COUNCIL

We recognise the importance of our industry body the Testing, Inspection and Certification Council (TIC),

and have actively engaged with them to improve compliance across our Group and we participate in

annual audits of our processes and documentation. We are active members of their Legal and Ethics

Committee and we continue to meet our commitments as laid down by the TIC. TIC has provided all

members with their Compliance Code which is audited annually and defines the standard code of conduct

and principles to which TIC members are required to comply which includes Modern Slavery requirements.

**KNOW YOUR CLIENT** 

We annually review our client onboarding, tendering and procurement practices in relation to modern

slavery. To ensure our effectiveness we continuously monitor any third party we work with in the following

ways:

• 24 hour monitored updates for sanctions and adverse media;

• A periodic review and request for third parties to submit an annual acceptance of AHK policies, in

particular anti-bribery and corruption; and

• Periodic review of third party's payment requests and payments.

**COMBATING SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING** 

We continue to use our network of trusted suppliers and have improved vetting of new suppliers

(including financial, sanctions and adverse media checks) we are pleased to say that to date, we have not

identified any instance of modern slavery across our supply chain.

**CONTINUING COMMITMENT** 

We recognise the need to continuously improve our efforts to prevent any modern slavery in our

operations and supply chains. In response, AHK has committed to growing our compliance and

environmental, social and governance structures with additional hires, including a new direct head of

Environmental, Social and Governance.
